



APPRENTICE PLUMBER CAMP CONSTRUCTION & MAINTENANCE

The apprentice plumber is a key member of the Terra team, responsible for field installation and maintenance of equipment and camps for Terra Water Systems Inc. The ideal candidate is working toward their ticket and is enrolled in their 2nd or 3rd year apprentice plumber program. A jack-of-all trades; they are able to tackle challenges related to remote camp installs and maintenance. The position would require up to 3 weeks of work remote at a time, with occasional in-town work. Responsibilities include:

- Work with on-site Terra-contracted labor and assist in the installation, maintenance, and repair of all plumbing, heating, gas piping and other related equipment.
- Assist with installation, set-up and tear out of remote camps and ancillary equipment.
- Troubleshoot and carry out equipment maintenance requirements on a periodic basis.
- Work with Terra operations staff on site and identify/contribute to Terra's Continuous Improvement initiatives.
- Improve skill set and knowledge by taking part in industry and Terra sponsored training programs.
- Focus on safety practices and policies while completing all tasks.
- Build ancillary equipment as needed (pipe, hoses, lift stations, cords).
- Various other duties as required.

Education and experience:

- 2+ years in the remote work camp installation or maintenance;
- Registered Apprentice enrolled in 2nd or 3rd year

- A positive team player with strong work ethic who is reliable and punctual.
- Strong mechanical aptitude and problem solving skills.

- Operator tickets such as Telehandler, Aerial Work Platform and Skid Steer would be considered an asset.
